we are reaching to you via this invitation card as we would like to invite you to the *Prague Conference on Political Economy 2010*. The Prague Conference on Political Economy is an international and interdisciplinary gathering of scholars and supporters (not only) of the Austrian School of Economics and political economy of freedom. During two days of the conference, participants will have an opportunity to participate in lectures and debates focusing on economics, history, philosophy and other humanities, and to discuss these issues with leading theorists in the field, both from Europe and overseas.

The 'PCPE' now enters its 6th year and is organized jointly by the Liberální institut, Prague, and the CEVRO Institute College, Prague. The PCPE 2010 will take place on March 19 – 21, 2010 in a newly reconstructed old-time building in the very heart of Prague.

Like every year, the conference will begin with a presentation of two prizes and, accordingly, with two memorial lectures delivered by their recipients.

We will have the pleasure to welcome two extraordinary scholars: Richard Epstein (University of Chicago and New York University), who will deliver the Wieser Memorial Lecture, and G. R. Steele (Lancaster University), who will deliver the Cuhel Memorial Lecture. Moreover, on the evening of Thursday, March 18, there will be a pre-conference event, a launch of Prof. Epstein's book with the author as the main speaker.
